Notice is hereby given that on Wednesday, November 12, 2025, immediatly following the completion of the Public Hearing on the proposed 2026 town budget, which begins at 6:00 pm at the La Grange Town Hall, a special town meeting of the electors, called by the town board pursuant to s.60.12(1)(c) Wis Sat will be held for the following purposes:

1. To approve the 2025 Town Tax Levy to be collected in 2026 pursuant to Sec. 60.10(1)(a) of the Wis Stat.

The Towns of LaGrange and Byron are engaged in a joint 2026 Agricultural Road Improvement Program project to reconstruct portions of Formica, Estate, and Essex Roads. The value of that project is \$3.1M but has not been included in the budget as 90% of the project will be funded by the State and the remaining 10% will be funded by the Ho-Chunk Nation Transportation Authority so no Town funds are expected to be expended in support of it.
